# Introduction, Background, & Methodology:

- 1. **Brief description of the recipient and project**: The Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food & Markets (VAAFM) is in Montpelier, Vermont. The VAAFM is the designated State Lead Agency (SLA) for pesticide regulation under FIFRA Sections 23 and 24. The mission of the VAAFM: "facilitate, support, and encourage the growth and viability of agriculture in Vermont while protecting the working landscape, human health, animal health, plant health, consumers, and the environment."
- 2. **Description of the grant work-plan commitments:** Under the Cooperative Agreement, VAAFM agreed to conduct and enhance pesticide use, sales, and enforcement data tracking using the \$28,377 award. The initial plan was to obtain software licenses for 7-10 VAAFM staff and allocate the remaining funds to development hours for the state-contracted information technology contractor.
- 3. Describe previous recommendations if any exist: There are none.
- 4. How was the review conducted? Post-Award Monitoring was conducted via a desk review by Project Officer, Maya Babu, with a subsequent conference call on February 6, 2023. This review was conducted in accordance with EPA's PO Advanced Monitoring Review Guidance, Protocol and Mandatory Report Format. Participants in the review included: Maya Babu (EPA), Frank Gardner (EPA), David Huber (VAAFM), and Morgan Griffith (VAAFM).
