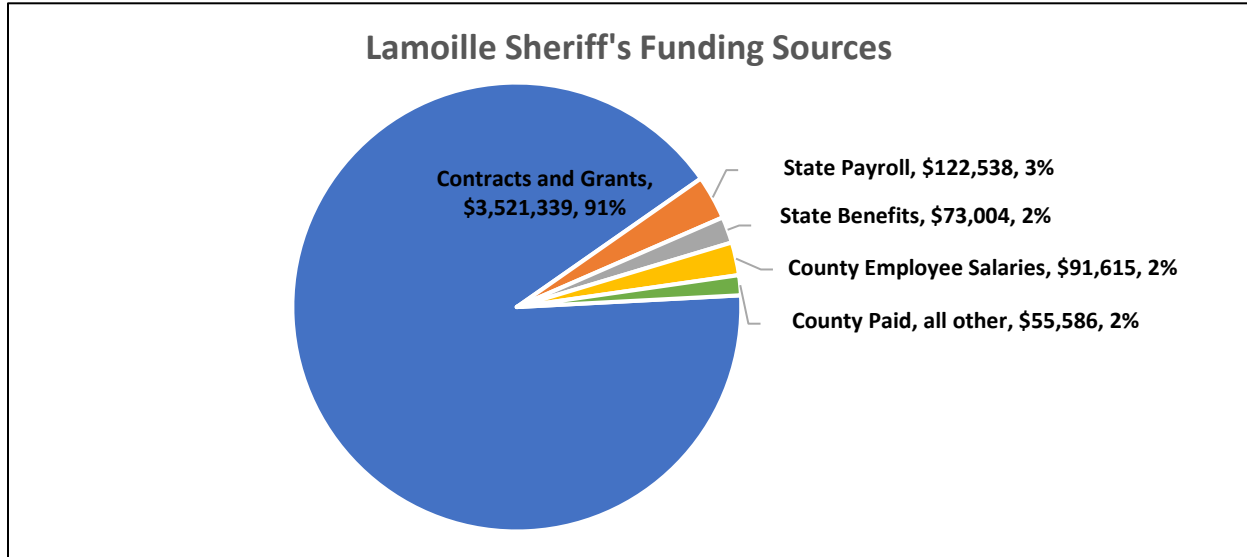


Fiscal Year 2018 Lamoille County Sheriff's Department Funding
